ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This year the Providence Newspaper Guild will be awarding a number of \$1,000 scholarships (regular scholarships) and \$500 scholarships (wild card scholarships).

The regular scholarships will be awarded to the following members of the nominating Guild members' immediate families: Husband, wife, sister, brother, father, mother, step-parent, son or daughter (natural or adopted) step-child, grandparent or grand child, or other member of the nominating Guild member's immediate household. In the event of a change in status, the relationship at the time of the drawing will prevail.

The wild card scholarship will be awarded to individuals who do not qualify for the regular scholarship.

Scholarship candidates must be sponsored by Guild members in good standing. **This means the Guild member's dues must have been fully paid within the 30 days prior to the scholarship drawing.** Members may sponsor only one candidate for each category of scholarship (regular and wildcard). Children and family members of Guild members who are delinquent in their dues are not eligible for the wildcard scholarship.

In no case will either scholarship be awarded to an individual employed by the Providence Journal, the Worcester Telegram & Gazette, the Pawtucket Times or the Woonsocket Call, or the Enterprise

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Candidate names may be entered once into each of two drawings, (depending on their relationship to the sponsor) one for the regular scholarship, one for the wild card scholarship. If an individual is sponsored more than once for either drawing, his/her name will be placed in the drawing only once.

All **scholarship candidates must be enrolled full-time** (as defined by the institution) in an accredited, post-secondary educational institution for the 2018-2019 academic year.

All winning candidates must provide proof of enrollment, such as a current tuition bill, before scholarship monies will be remitted. In the event a candidate wins both drawings, the winner shall only be entitled to the larger of the two scholarships.

In the event a non-qualifying candidate is selected, the Guild member making the nomination will be given the opportunity to substitute the name of an individual who does qualify for that category of scholarship (regular or wildcard). If a qualified candidate cannot be substituted there will be a new drawing from the remaining nominations. In the case of the regular scholarship, a Guild member with two or more qualified family/household members in school may divide the scholarship among these individuals.
